To begin, I would like to thank you for helping us start this year off with a bang! I am so proud and thankful to all our families for the love, support, and preparation you've shown to your children over the summer. It was truly heartwarming to see so many families at our Open House, and I look forward to strengthening our current relationship and welcoming you to the ECC family!

Visiting

Per the Denmark School District Safety and Security Plan, parents are to drop students off and pick students up outside of the school building in the designated areas. We will continue to have all available staff outside welcoming your student through the first weeks of school, then transition to supporting students while inside the building as they navigate to their classrooms.

Per district-policy, the ECC will limit non-essential visitors and visits during the regular scheduled school day, and any volunteers will be allowed and pre approved by administration and a background check. Please contact the school office if you have any questions about volunteering.

Early Childhood Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS)

The goal of Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) is to create a positive experience for each child through evidence-based practices that promote child engagement and learning while focusing on teaching children the appropriate social skills they'll use to develop friendships and regulate their emotions. As we begin the school year we are working hard to teach our students what it means to Be Respectful, Be Responsible, and Be Safe.

Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Safe

The ECC creates a high-quality learning environment by teaching these behavioral expectations:

Being **Respectful** means:

- · Using a voice volume of 0 or 1 in the hallway
- Taking turns
- Offering help to a friend
- Using your own space

Being **Responsible** means:

- Using kind words
- · Ensuring your backpack, coat, etc. are hung on your hook
- · Flushing the toilet after using the bathroom
- Placing trash in the garbage

Being Safe means:

- Using walking feet in the hallway
- Keeping your hands to yourself
- · Washing your hands after using the bathroom
- Using equipment safely

Classes will have the opportunity to earn **Viking Gold** for showing expected behavior in their classroom as well as the various areas of our school like the hallway and playground. Once they have reached their class goal they will receive a reward. Some of the rewards include: extra outside time, dance parties, special snacks, guest readers, dress-up days, and lots more!

Breakfast

The ECC will happily serve breakfast to any of our 5K or AM 4K students. If you would like your child to eat breakfast in the morning, please make sure they are at school on time as we can only serve breakfast until 8:00; any service after 8:00 runs the risk of students not being able to participate in the ECC's classroom activities.

Parking

When picking up, dropping off, or visiting the ECC, please see the map below that provides you with parking opportunities at the ECC. Any blacktop to the South (the old bank and ball diamond) are technically not ECC property and, therefore. have no designated parking spots. Please ensure the safety of yourselves and others if/when parking in these areas.

It is imperative that you accompany your child(ren) when arriving at the ECC to ensure their safety while in the parking lot. Also, though our main entrance is typically supervised until 8:10 daily, there are instances in which our staff are handling a variety of situations; this could lead to children without adult supervision if they are not accompanied by an adult.



N Wall St

N Wall St is usually closed to thru traffic, with the exception of buses during the morning arrival. We recommended navigating through the parking lot, behind the BMO Harris Bank and Lickety Splits, and exiting by the softball diamonds.

Parents / Visitors

Parents will not be allowed in the building again this year, unless you have scheduled an appointment ahead of time. We welcome volunteers, as long as you have a scheduled time and have an approved background check on file. Background checks can be found on the district website under the "community" tab.

If you need to pick up your child early, please call the ECC office at 920-863-4175 ahead of time so that we can have your child ready at the designated time. When you arrive for pickup, please call or press the button to the left of the inside front door. Our front doors will remain locked at all times. Thank you for your cooperation.

Volunteer Background Check / Chaperoning

If you plan on volunteering at school, we will need a current volunteer background check on file. In addition, please complete our Chaperone Agreement form if you plan to attend field trips during the school year.



Student Fees

Please remember that student fees are \$10 per student. This fee is payable by September 16th. Payments can easily be made online via your Infinite Campus Portal (includes a \$2 fee) or you can send cash or check in a clearly marked envelope that states student fees along with your child's name and teacher.

Contacting Your Child's Teacher

Teacher's are unable to answer their phones during school hours, except in the case of an emergency. Parents may leave a message and ask a teacher to call them back.

Ask your child's teacher if they have a preferred method of contact (phone, email, Seesaw message, etc.)

Birthday Treats

ALL birthday treats must be store bought, with a store label on it. This is due to food allergies, among other reasons. We appreciate your understanding.

School Bags / Backpacks

Because of numerous projects, handouts, and parent information, it is important for each child to bring a backpack or school bag to school daily. Please remember to check your child's backpack at the end of each day. Your involvement is the key to your child's success in school.



REMINDER

As a safety measure - please do not attach or let your child clip on items such as toys or key chains items to their schoolbag.
